Dear Students & Parents,

TROT is trying a new lesson format for the 2008-2009 season. We will continue to have a Fall and Spring Term. Both terms will consist of 12 lessons with a week long break. With the scheduled breaks in place, our rider families and volunteers can schedule necessary appointments, vacations, and other activities without having to miss a TROT lesson. The breaks will allow our volunteers and horses to have some time to refresh and revive and we can do extra trainings to fill volunteer teams.

Fees will stay the same with a group lessons at \$350, semi-private at \$420, and private lessons at \$490 per semester. However, Hippotherapy will be raised \$15 to be \$75 per therapy session.
